

 - To promote efforts to delay the onset of CKD




MoKP's FY 14/15 Total State Appropriation =\$1,695,000




Demographics of MoKP Clients: FY15


- 1,448 patients assisted (13% of all MO ESRD pts.)
- ALL low income (<150 % FPL for dialysis; < 250% FPL for transplant)
- 36% transplant patient
- 64% dialysis patients
- Gender: 54% male; 46% female
- 75% urban
- 164 dialysis or transplant facilities
